

CARE THAT COMES TO YOU The NorthStar Palliative Care team comes right to you – there's no need to schedule an office visit. All NorthStar Palliative Care visits are in the comfort of wherever you call home, whether it is a private residence, an assisted living or a skilled nursing facility.

WHO PAYS FOR IT? As part of standard benefits, Medicare Part B and Medicaid cover some NorthStar Palliative Care medications and treatments, including visits from doctors and nurse practitioners. Medicare Part B covers 80% of charges and is subject to a co-pay and deductible. Co-pays are billed to secondary insurance and/or covered by the family.

Many insurance providers offer complete or partial coverage for NorthStar Palliative Care, just like other hospital or medical services. The NorthStar Palliative Care teams can help you and your family understand coverage and payment options.

CAN I BENEFIT FROM NORTHSTAR PALLIATIVE CARE?

NorthStar Palliative Care may be a good choice if you are experiencing any of the following:

YOUR ILLNESS OR DISEASE is progressing with symptoms that are not responding to medical treatment

YOUR ABILITY to complete activities of daily living are declining

YOU ARE HAVING DIFFICULTY controlling physical or emotional symptoms, including weight loss and psychological or spiritual distress

THERE IS UNCERTAINTY regarding your prognosis or your goals of care

YOU HAVE HAD MULTIPLE hospitalizations and/or you have had difficulty managing treatments

Among many diseases, NorthStar Palliative Care most often treats people suffering from the symptoms and stress of serious illnesses such as cancer, congestive heart failure (CHF), chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), kidney disease, late-stage Alzheimer's Disease, Parkinson's Disease, and Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS).
